TLB-6235 — A full-time four-wheel-drive system provides ultimate traction control for Allmand's largest TLB. Powered by a 35-horsepower diesel engine, the TLB-6235 design features ESL technology, as well as an overall loader design with a higher reach and improved dump angle, allowing the TLB-6235's 1/2-cubic-yard loader bucket to dump loads where other compact tractors cannot reach.
